- Birth Certificate (with photo ID)
- U.S. Naturalization Certificate or U.S. Citizenship Certificate
- Permanent Resident Card (Green Card)
- Foreign Passport (with Temporary I-551 ADIT Stamp or Printed Notation on MRIV)
- Employment Authorization Document (Form I-766, with Category Code A03 or A05)

We ask for this documentation to ensure compliance with federal regulations and to maintain the integrity of our secure operations.

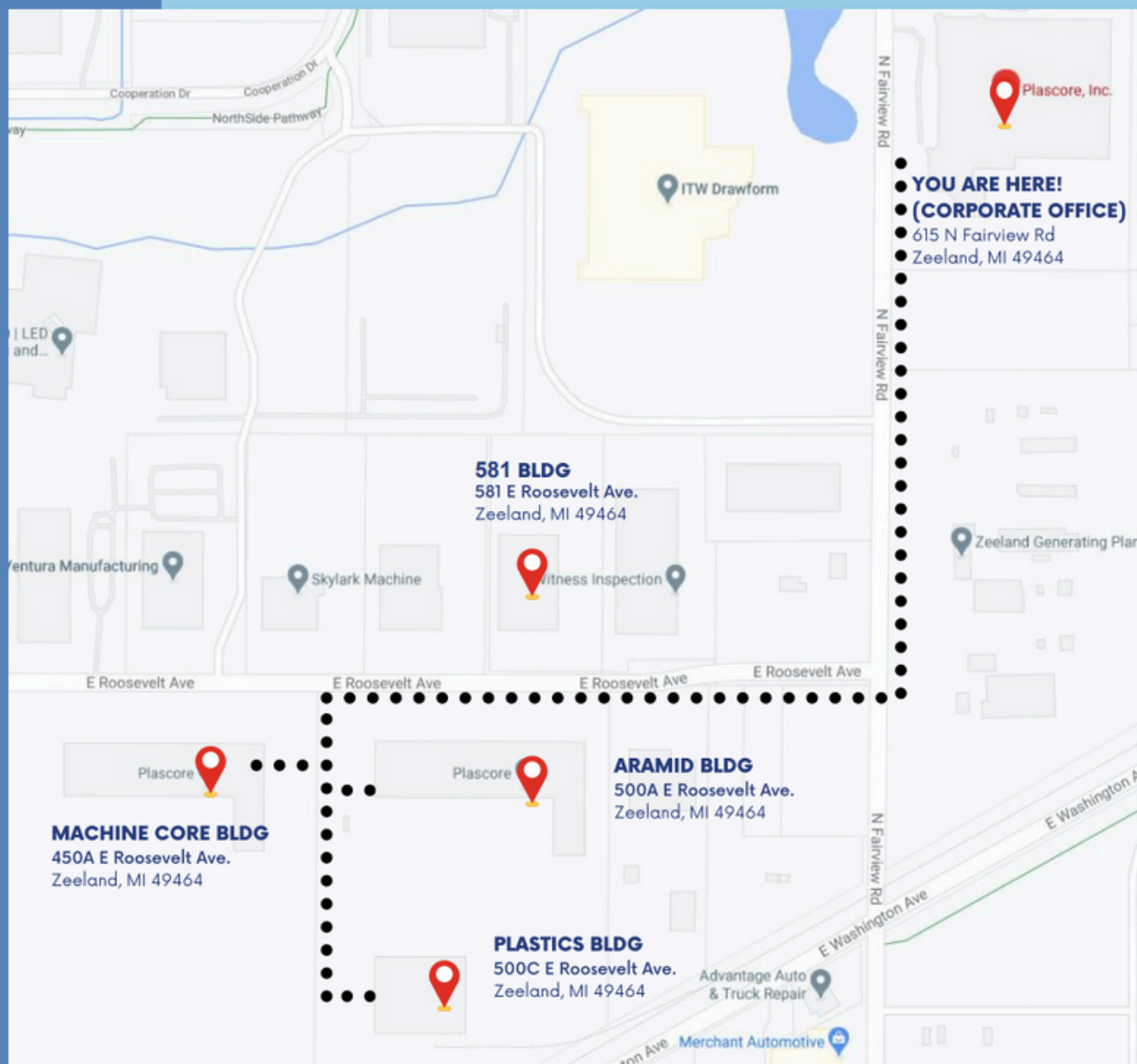
## PLASCORE LOCATION GUIDE

As you might have noticed, Plascore has five separate locations. We ask that you check in at the corporate office, then navigate to your meeting location, if need-be. Please take a look at the graphic below to location each Plascore building. This tool is quite helpful when navigating to and from each location.

# FIND YOUR WAY AT PLASCORE

### From the Corporate office:

- Take a left out of the parking lot until you reach Roosevelt Avenue. (0.3 miles)
- Turn right on Roosevelt Avenue.
- Drive another 0.3 miles until you reach the Plascore entryway on the left-hand side of the street. The pathway leads to the Machine Core, Aramid and Plastics facilities. Tip: Look for 3 big brown and red buildings!
- For **Machine Core**, take a quick right turn on the main drive. Enter building through Door A.
- For **Aramid**, take a quick left turn on the main drive. Enter building through Door B.
- For **Plastics**, continue driving to the end of the pathway. Plastics is the last building on your left! Enter building through Door A.
